Jesus: The Lonely Road to the Cross

The Battle to the Cross Begins Mark 14:32-41

The Setting:

- They crossed the Kidron Brook = "Murky, DARK" - John 18:1
- David crossed this brook when fleeing Absalom 2 Samuel 15
- Both David and Jesus crossed this brook as kings without a THRONE.
- Gethsemane = "OIL PRESS", an olive grove

Preparation:

Jesus was PREPARED for the battle ahead - John 14:30b

- 1. Preparation of HEART
 - Jesus kept His life free from SIN
 - Satan did not have any FOOTHOLDS in His life *Rt. Ephesians 4:27*
- 2. Preparation of MIND
 - Jesus was in constant communication with the Father, through PRAYER.

Priority of Prayer

- 1. Jesus had a PLACE of prayer Luke 22:39-40
 - a. The place was SECLUDED
 - b. The place was SILENT
 - c. The place was SET
- 2. Jesus had PASSION in his prayer Mark 14:35; Luke 22:41-44
 - a. In His passion, Jesus was SUBMISSIVE ${\scriptstyle -\,Lk\,22:42}$
 - b. In His agony, Jesus was STRENGTHENED ${\scriptstyle -\,Lk.\,\,22:43}$
 - *Hematidrosis (sweating blood)* tiny blood vessels that cause bloody sweat are more likely to rupture under intense stress. The stress can be physical, psychological, or both.

The first SIN committed by mankind, was in a GARDEN. The first BLOOD shed for us, by Jesus, was in a GARDEN.

- 3. Jesus had PERSISTENCE in his prayer Mark 14:39 & 41
- 4. Jesus called PARTNERS to prayer Mark 14:38
